WEATHER

The weather is unpredictable this time of year with very cold and clear days mixed with rainy and windy ones, and the odd sunny day as well!



FAUNA

Signs of baby animals begin to appear alongside their parents. Be careful of swooping koolbardi (magpie) and djidi djidi (willy wag tails) protecting their nests.



FLORA

Masses of flowers begin to bloom, beginning with the bright yellow buds of the acacia and followed by the blues and purples of the blueberry lilly and the native wisteria.



CULTURAL HISTORY

As the weather warmed and vegetation began to flourish, Noongar people would traditionally move closer to the coast ready for the approaching hotter seasons.
