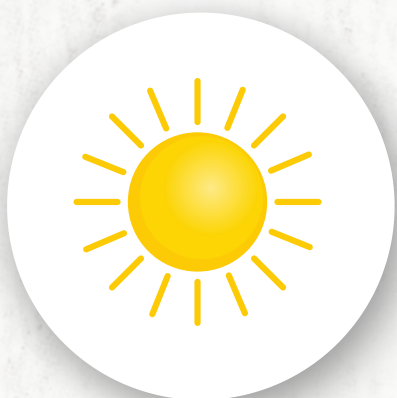


The Noongar Season of the second summer

a coastal sea breeze.



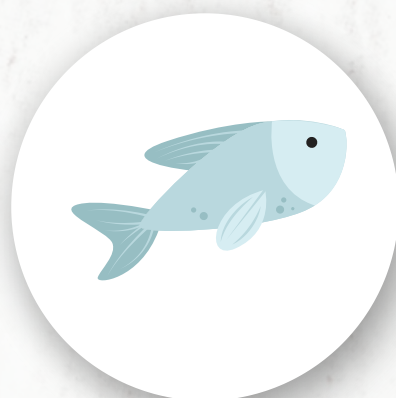
FAUNA
