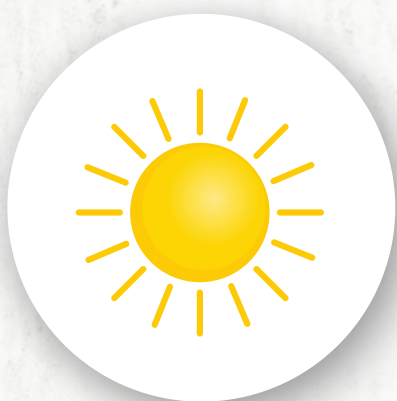


The Noongar Season of the Wildflowers
